Sample Schedule

Below is an example of a typical AHS schedule.

Please note how the student's schedule is designed so that he/she doesn't travel from one end of the building to the other end without a "layover" in the middle part of the building.

The first digit of the room number represents what floor where the room is located. 1=first floor and 2=second floor.

The second digit of the room number represents the location in the building. 1=East Wing, 2 and 3=middle (music, art, technology, gym, main office, guidance, library, science) and 4=West Wing.

Also, notice how the semesters indicate the marking periods: (i.e. 4th period Lunch 12 = marking periods 1 and 2, otherwise known as first semester, and 4th period Lunch 34 = marking periods 3 and 4, otherwise known as second semester).

The day pattern is indicated by:

ABCD = every day

AC = A and C days only

BD = B and D days only
