The Backpack Program: Together with the Food Bank of the Hudson Valley, OPS families, staff, local businesses, and community members, we are able to provide food to our students that are experiencing food scarcity. A grocery bag full of food is sent home with these students every Friday. (We are only able to accept monetary donations for this program.)



The Turkey Drive: Families receive a frozen turkey (along with other food items) for the Thanksgiving holiday. This drive is organized and supported by our local Cub Scout troop as well as by our OPS families, local businesses, and community members.



The Giving Tree: We collect gifts to ensure that the holiday season is a merry and bright one for *all* our students. These gifts are donated to us by our OPS families, staff, local businesses, and community members.



The Nest is a discreet space here at OPS where members of our school community can “shop” for health and hygiene products such as toothbrushes, toothpaste, soap, diapers, lotion, detergent and other items. The Nest is open daily and all items are free. Like all of our other Giving programs, there is no funding source for this program.
