Welcome to Lifespan Studies. This is a half year course that focuses on growth and development across the entire lifespan-conception to old age. The course is ideal for those interested in the fields of psychology, teaching or any career where you will be involved with people in different stages along the lifespan. There will be units test and projects as well as a cumulative final exam at the end of the course.

Supplies: A small (1") binder / loose leaf paper

Grades are weighted in the following way:

- Projects/In-class assignments/journal entries: 35 %
- Tests/Quizzes: 35 %
- Preparation & Readiness 30%

Preparation & readiness points (**10 per class period**) will be given DAILY for students who are present; on time, prepared with pen/pencil and binder and who positively contribute to the class discussion. All homework, tests, activities/journaling and projects will count towards your average.

**Some assessments will be completed and scored using *Socrative*. Students will use their phones/computers in-class to complete the questions. This method allows instant results so we can go over gaps in the learning immediately.
