


Atlas Login Procedures

Schools have several options for Atlas login. Please find your login option below and follow the steps to begin using Atlas.

Option 1: Atlas Main Login

Starting from an email link sent by your school:

- If you are a new user, check your email Inbox for a **Welcome to Atlas** email from “Atlas Curriculum Management”. Click the link in your email to get started.
- The first time you log in, Atlas will prompt you to register your account. Your name and email address have already been provided by your school administration. Simply create a private Atlas Password to complete the registration.


Starting from your school's Atlas URL

- You can find your School's Atlas URL by asking your school leadership or going to: <https://www.rubicon.com/find-my-atlas/>
- On your Atlas login page, enter your email address and click **Next**.

 *If your email is not recognized, contact your school administrator to check your account.*

- Next, enter your password and click **Sign In**.

 *If you don't know your password, click the **Forgot password?** link under the password field, to receive a password reset email.*



Login Troubleshooting

If you receive this error message when logging in to Atlas, it means you have entered an email address that does not match the one in Atlas, or your Atlas account has not been set up yet.

What to do:

If you receive the following error message when logging in to Atlas, it means you're using the **wrong URL**.

**What to do:**

- Don't use saved bookmarks, or links. Instead, type in your school's Atlas URL in the browser's address bar. The correct URL should look like: <https://schoolname.rubiconatlas.org>.
- If you don't know your school's correct URL, click the word **here** in the error message, or go to <https://www.rubicon.com/find-my-atlas/> to find your school's Atlas URL.
