Character Mood Graph

1. Each person should choose a different character from the book group novel you read (if you are able to communicate with your group.) (For *Maus* you should either choose present Vladek or past Vladek if you want to work with Vladek's character.) If you are not able to communicate with your group, just choose any character you would like.
2. Each person should select four points for his or her character. Each point should be a significant or important event in the character's life.
3. Each point must be developed into a written paragraph. Each paragraph must contain the following:
 - Label each point with a descriptive name and explain when it is found in the novel.
 - Briefly summarize each point. In a few sentences, describe what is going on at this point in the novel.
 - Rate this point. For each point, rate the character's feelings on a scale of negative ten to positive ten. Negative ten is the lowest mood, zero is neutral, and positive ten is the happiest mood. You must also explain why you rate each point as you do.
 - Provide a quotation, including page number, that reflects the character's mood at the point of the story.
4. You must provide a visual graph charting your character's changes in mood.
 - Label the graph.
 - Label the x-axis as Page Numbers. The x-axis will only need positive numbers.
 - Label the y-axis as Mood.
 - Provide a key.
 - All graphs must be neat, colorful, and reflect the appropriate amount of effort.
