POETRY NOTES

Poetry is a type of literature that expresses ideas and feelings.

Poem Form	<p>Line - A group of words together on one line of the poem.</p> <p>Stanza- A group of lines arranged together.</p> <p>Stanza</p> <div><p><i>A word is dead When it is said, Some say.</i></p><p><i>I say it just Begins to live That day.</i></p></div>
Refrain	A sound, word, phrase, or line repeated in a poem, usually at the end of each stanza or verse.
Tone	The feeling, emotion , or attitude the narrator has toward a subject.
Alliteration	Consonant sounds repeated at the beginning of words.
Simile	Comparison of two unlike things using like or as .
Metaphor	Comparison of two unlike things, not using like or as .
Imagery	Language that provides a sensory experience using sight, sound, smell, touch, taste .
Onomatopoeia	Words that sound like the sound they are naming.
Symbolism	The use of a word or object which represents a deeper meaning, stands for something else.
