Poem Form	Line - A group of words together on one line of the poem. A word is dead	
	Stanza- A group of lines arranged together. When it is said, Some say.

Refrain	A sound, word, phrase, or line repeated in a poem, usually at the end of each stanza or verse.	
Tone	The feeling, emotion, or attitude the narrator has toward a subject.	
Alliteration	Consonant sounds repeated at the beginning of words.	
Simile	Comparison of two unlike things using like or as.	
Metaphor	Comparison of two unlike things, not using like or as.	
Imagery	Language that provides a sensory experience using sight, sound, smell, touch, taste.	
Onomatopoeia	Words that sound like the sound they are naming.	
Symbolism	The use of a word or object which represents a deeper meaning, stands for something else.
