## Starting Your Own Business

### Start Up Information

1. Form a company of 5 students and create a business name.
2. Discuss strengths and weaknesses of group members and assign general roles accordingly.
3. Exchange contact information so you can share work from home.
4. Develop a fashion-related product to design, make and sell.
5. Promote the product through advertisement and promotion
6. Sell the product (at least 45 minutes of your sales must be at a table set up in school).
7. Keep accurate inventory records while keeping money, supplies and products secure.
8. Donate 10% of profits to a class selected charity.

### Start Up Supply List

\*White binder with clear page holder in front

\*Money box

\*Storage box or sturdy bag for inventory

\*\$5 per student to buyer

### Grading System

\*10 points daily for individual participation based on attendance and visible project work (10 x 20 days = 200 points)

\*100 points for the binder

**After 5 days of absence (regardless of reason) a student will be removed from the group and assigned an individual project to complete for the binder grade. This takes pressure off of the group and helps the student pass the course.**
